WONDERBUG DISCOVERIES (AGES 18 MONTHS-3 YEARS WITH PARENT) (ACY)

This parent-child nature discovery program is highly sensory-based involving themed storybooks, songs, hands-on time, and outdoor time with exploratory walks through the Purdy Nature Preserve. Each week will focus on a different seasonal theme or topic in nature. A portion of each class will be held outdoors, weather permitting, so dress accordingly!

YOUNG EXPLORERS (AGES 2-4) (ACY)

We will use our senses to discover and investigate the wonderful sounds, colors, shapes, smells and textures of the natural world. We will incorporate outdoor exploration time, storybooks, songs, games and crafts. Each week will focus on a different topic in nature. A portion of each class will be held outdoors, weather permitting, so dress accordingly!

ANIMALS IN THE FALL (AGES 3-5 YEARS) (ACY) (SESSION 1)

Discover how animals get ready for winter through hibernation, migration and food collection. We will learn about black bears, ducks and geese, squirrels and more through stories, games, and simple crafts. Class will go outside when the weather allows, so please have children dressed for the weather.

CREEPY CRITTERS (AGES 3-5 YEARS) (ACY) (SESSION 2)

We will learn about nocturnal creatures such as raccoons, skunks, owls, bats, spiders and more through stories, games, and hand-on learning. Find out why it can be exciting instead of creepy to hear strange sounds outdoors at nighttime. Class will go outside when weather allows, so please have children dressed for the weather.

OUTRAGEOUS OUTDOORS (AGES 3-5 YEARS) (ACY)

This exciting class gives your child a chance to learn all about the beauty and wonder of the natural world through hands-on activities, games, stories and crafts related to the nature theme of the week, as well as time outdoors exploring nature. Class will end with time for lunch, so please pack a nutritional lunch (peanut and tree-nut free) for your child, and have them dressed for the weather. Children can be transferred to and from other preschool classes within the Apple Creek YMCA.

LIVE ANIMAL CARE (AGES 6-12 YEARS) (ACY)

Drop your child off on the second Saturday of each month in the Nature Study Classroom to learn how we care for our classroom animals, including snakes, lizards, turtles, frogs and fish. Help feed the animals, clean their tanks, and make sure they are living healthy lives.

ARCHERY 101 (AGES 8-16) (ACY)

Learn the basics of archery in this class including the '11 steps to becoming a successful archer.' Class follows the NASP guidelines and is taught by an NASP Certified Instructor. All equipment is provided. Class will be held outdoors and is only available during session 1.

ADVANCED ARCHERY (AGES 10-18 YEARS) (ACY)

This class is designed for experienced archers. Archery 101 is a prerequisite. Various targets are used including 3D. Equipment is provided by the Y, however, personal bows are encouraged. Class is held outdoors.
